## **Become an effective communicator**

- Use words, gestures, and simple sentences to communicate
- Listen to stories and respond to questions
- Learn new words and begin to use language to express needs and ideas

## **Develop a positive sense of myself**

- Build relationships with familiar adults and peers
- Begin to express emotions and learn how to manage them
- Develop confidence, independence, and a sense of belonging

## **Understand the foundation for developing healthy bodies**

- Develop fine and gross motor skills through active play
- Build confidence in climbing, running, and balancing
- Begin to develop independence in self-care routines with support

## **Gain a lifelong passion for reading and writing**

- Enjoy sharing books, joining in with stories, songs, and rhymes
- Begin to recognise familiar pictures, symbols, and print
- Explore mark making and early drawing using a variety of tools

## **Develop a curiosity and observe the world around us**

- Explore the environment with growing confidence and independence
- Investigate natural materials and everyday objects
- Begin to notice similarities and differences in people, places, and routines

## **Create an expressive imagination**

- Take part in role play and imaginative activities
- Express ideas through music, movement, and art
- Experiment with a range of materials and textures

## **Build a mastery of mathematics**

- Begin to count through play and everyday routines
- Explore concepts such as big and small, full and empty, and shape
- Enjoy sorting, matching, and simple pattern-making activities
