Develop a positive sense of myself

- Form secure attachments with familiar adults
- Feel safe, comforted, and confident in their environment
- Begin to express emotions and have them recognised and supported

Understand the foundation for developing healthy bodies

- Develop fine and gross motor skills through active play
- Build strength, balance, and coordination
- Be supported during care routines to develop healthy habits

Become an effective communicator

- Communicate through sounds, gestures, and early words
- Enjoy listening to songs, stories, and familiar voices
- Take part in simple back-and-forth interactions

Gain a lifelong passion for reading and writing

- Enjoy sharing books, looking at pictures, and listening to stories
- Explore mark making through early scribbles using a variety of tools
- Develop a love of songs, rhymes, and familiar stories

Develop a curiosity and observe the world around us

- Explore the environment through play and discovery
- Investigate everyday objects using all of the senses
- Begin to notice people, places, and familiar routines

Create an expressive imagination

- Express feelings through sounds, movements, and facial expressions
- Enjoy music, singing, and movement activities
- Explore creative materials through sensory and messy play

Build a mastery of mathematics

- Begin to notice numbers in everyday routines
- Explore concepts such as size, shape, and quantity through play
- Enjoy sorting, filling, emptying, and cause-and-effect activities
